

2024 National Silver Gloves Frequently Asked Questions Stoney Creek Hotel - Independence, MO February 1 -3, 2024



BOXERS

What day should I arrive?

Boxers & coaches should be checked into their hotel Wednesday, January 31st so all boxers are inside the Ballroom (males) or Water Room (females) for weigh-ins Thursday at 6:00am.

When do I need to go to weigh-ins?

Weigh-ins are held at 6:00am. <u>Males in the Ballroom</u> & <u>Females in the Water Room</u>

Thursday morning 6am to 9am ALL boxers must weigh-in.

Friday morning 6am to 8am Only athletes boxing Friday must weigh-in. Saturday morning 6am to 8am Only athletes boxing Saturday must weigh-in.

How will I know when I box? Bout sheets will be posted at www.ringside.com/tournaments.

Where do I get School Excuse Forms? Pick them up at the announcer's table.

When can I glove-up for my bout?

You can go to the glove table 3 bouts in advance of your bout. The glove table Official will check your handwraps, mouthpiece and headgear before having you put on the gloves.

What if I am unopposed at the National Tournament?

Unopposed athletes do not need to attend the Tournament. Your medal will be mailed!

COACHES **Note Important Updates for 2024 Tournament**

Coaches check-in their athletes, directly with their Regional Director (RD).

Coaches check in boxers at Stoney Creek, on Wednesday, January 31st and turn in passbooks to RDs for all boxers who are at the tournament. Per Silver Gloves, there is a "no bout minimum" and non-citizens can participate.

** Check-in closes at 4pm!** RDs will be in the following rooms from Noon - 4pm Wednesday.

Metal Room: Regions 1, 2, 3 & 4 Water Room: Regions 5, 6, 7 & 8.

Current USA Boxing registered Coaches who want to work a corner at National Silver Gloves, are required to pre-register before January 9, 2024. https://forms.gle/JttKL5pMeCxVgFXu6

Coaches have a 5PM meeting Wednesday, in the Ballroom.

Safe Sport must be current and not expire until February 4, 2024, or later.

Officials have a 6PM mandatory meeting Wednesday, in the Fire Room.
